Town hall Update: The YFS held a town hall on Tuesday November 25 at 1pm as a forum for students to come and voice their concerns and receive information about frequently asked questions. Both members from the administration and members from CUPE were invited to attend to answer questions. Unfortunately, members of the admin declined the invitation and only CUPE members came to address questions about the current labour disruption.

Overall, the town hall lasted just under 4 hours and was very successful. Future town halls will be held on an as needs basis and students are encouraged to continue e-mailing questions to strikeinfo@yfs.ca.

Negotiations Update: Members of CUPE 3903 and York University are still in negotiations. The first meeting took place on Thursday November 27, and the meetings will continue back and forth until both parties are satisfied with the agreement.

If an agreement is reached, the proposal will then be presented to the CUPE membership at a GMM on Wednesday December 3, where members will vote to accept or decline the proposal. Wednesday will be a significant day in determining whether the strike will end, or continue.
