At their last GMM, CUPE also decided to allow the Bargaining Committee to put forward negotiating points without prior approval of the Executive Committee. If these points are agreed to they will be brought directly to the CUPE membership. This should help speed up the process.

The YFS has also set up a meeting with CUPE 3903 for this coming Tuesday to discuss with them any steps that can be taken to end the strike.

The York Administration has finally set up a time for us to meet with them. We will be meeting with them on Wednesday to discuss getting them back to the bargaining table.
